### 4.0 ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

### 4.1 GENERAL INFORMATION

This product should be assembled and/or repaired using good workmanship practices and proper tools. Bolts and elastic stopnuts should be tightened to a torque not to exceed industry standards for Grade '5' bolts. The 3/8-24 bolts should be tightened to 35 ft-lbs and the  $\frac{1}{2}-20$  bolts tightened to 85 ft-lbs.

All replacement parts must be the same as or equal to the original parts supplied.

### 4.2 PRE-USE CHECKS

- Identify and ensure all parts are present.
- Generally, check over the unit to assure the tightness of all nuts, bolts and screws with extension collapsed.

### 4.3 ASSEMBLY STEPS

Slide center extension inside base assembly. Adjust at desired height and insert lock pin.


- a) Product Model Number






