3.0 TRAINING

TRAINING REQUIREMENTS 3.1

The employer of the operator is responsible for providing a training program sufficient for the safe operation of the unit.

3.2 TRAINING PROGRAM

The employer provided operator training program should cover safety procedures concerning use of the unit in and around the intended aircraft at the intended aircraft servicing location.

3.3 **OPERATOR TRAINING**

The operator training should provide the required training for safe operation of the unit.

NOTE: Maintenance and Trouble Shooting are to be performed by a skilled and trained technician.

4.0 **PRE-USE CHECKS**

Refer to the Parts List and Illustration to identify and insure all parts are present.

- Generally, check over unit to ensure the tightness of all nuts, connectors and fittings
- Ensure proper installation of appropriate driver bit

5.0 **OPERATION**

- 1. Wear rubber gloves and safety goggles
- 2. Place the draining device below the drain valve
- 3. Ensure the draining device pin is aligned to the drain valve axis.
- 4. Use the draining device to open the drain valve by slowly pushing the stem halfway into the valve

NOTE:

- If you push the stem halfway, fuel will flow continuously. After the desired amount of fuel is removed it is not necessary to rotate the drain valve stem to close the drain valve. Remove the stem and the existing spring action will close the drain valve.
- If you accidentally push the stem full travel into the hard stop the drain valve may remain in the open position even if you stop pushing the draining device against it. In that event it will be necessary for you to turn the stem 30° (maximum) clockwise.
- Drain the tank until fuel going into the container has no water 5.
- Pull back the draining device to close the drain valve 6.

NOTE: If the drain valve does not close properly, with the aid of the draining device, slightly pus the stem and turn it 30º (maximum) clockwise.

CAUTION!

Before putting the draining device aside ensure the drain valve is closed. If you do not obey this precaution contamination of the environment can occur.

Ensure fuel has stopped flowing then remove the draining device from below the drain valve 7.

NOTE: If fuel should continue to leak replace the seat o-ring.

Do not smoke or use open flame while using the Fuel Sample Unit.

- 8. Examine the collected fuel for contamination, especially at the fuel/water interface
 - a. Ensure the fuel is free from contamination
 - If you see water in the fuel continue to drain the tank until all water is removed b.
 - C. If presence of sediments or sludge in the fuel is observed, complete the Inspection of Microorganisms in the Tanks

TROUBLE	PROBABLE CAUSE	ACTION
	Blockage in tube and/or cup	Inspect tube and cup for blockage and remove it
No fuel goes into the bottle	5/32" ball driver is broken	Inspect 5/32" ball driver, Replace if damaged
	Drain valve not pushed in all the way or faulty	Insure 5/32" ball driver is properly inserted into drain valve and push inward until fuel comes out
Fuel leaks from cup at end of tube assembly	Damaged cup. Adhesive may be cracked	Check for damage and replace cup
Fuel leaks from fittings and/or cap on bottle	Fittings and/or cap are not tightened properly	Properly tighten fittings and/or cap
Fuel leaks from bottle	Bottle is damaged	Check for damage and replace bottle

- c) Description of the problem


